**A NECESSARY CHANGE FOR THE PREOCCUPIED
FOSSIL GENUS NAME *PLATYCHITON* HOARE, 2001
(MOLLUSCA: POLYPLACOPHORA)**

**Family LEPIDOPLEURIDAE
Genus *HOAREUS* nom. nov.**

Platyechiton Hoare, 2001. J. Paleontol. 75 (1), Jan: 67. (Mollusca: Polyplacophora: Lepidopleurida: Lepidopleuridae). Preoccupied by *Platyechiton* Beier, 1960. Tierreich 74: 258. (Insecta: Orthoptera: Ensifera: Tettigonioidea: Tettigoniidae: Pseudophyllinae).

The neotropical katydid genus *Platyechiton* was described by Beier (1960) with the type species *Platyechiton surinamus* Beier, 1960 from Surinam. It is still used as a valid genus name in Orthoptera. It has three species as *Platyechiton amazonicus* Beier, 1960 from Brazil, *Platyechiton brunneus* Beier, 1960 from Guyana and *Platyechiton surinamus* Beier, 1960.

Subsequently, Hoare (2001) erected the fossil mollusc genus *Platyechiton* with the type species *Platyechiton gerki* Hoare, 2001 from the Mississippian (Osagean) of Iowa in USA. He gave the species *Platyechiton? dalriensis* (Etheridge, 1882) as the other species with a question mark in his work.

Thus, the genus *Platyechiton* Hoare, 2001 is a junior homonym of the genus *Platyechiton* Beier, 1960. So I propose *Hoareus* nom. nov. as a replacement name for *Platyechiton* Hoare, 2001.

Etymology: The name is dedicated to R. D. Hoare who is the author of the preexisting genus *Platyechiton*.
